



Bishop Dunne Admissions MAP Growth Admission Test Information Sheet

What is the MAP Growth test?

The MAP Growth test is a computer-adaptive test. Each applicant will begin with the grade level test to which they are applying. If they answer a question correctly, the next question is more challenging. If they answer a question incorrectly, the next one is easier. This type of assessment challenges top performers without overwhelming students whose skills are below grade level. The MAP Growth test measures what students know, regardless of their grade level.

The test is scored normed by utilizing anonymous data from more than 10 million students around the U.S. and will allow the Admissions Office to evaluate the applicant's academic standings compared to other students in their applying grade.

The MAP Growth test is administered on the computer, and includes multiple choice, drag-and-drop, and other types of questions.

How can I prepare my student for the MAP Growth test?

- December 3, 2022
- January 14, 2023
- January 21, 2023
- February 11, 2023

Testing will begin at 8:30 a.m. and should last approximately 2 hours.
