## Minutes

### Connie Stanger

- Recap of the district meeting with the superintendent.
- Focus was on social and emotional learning. Greetings at the door, talking with them and making the students feel comfortable
- Library- school procurement and maintenance committee will be used if there is a challenge for the book. 59 books currently on the list throughout the district.
- DOJ-discussed problems, the finding was that there was not enough follow up with the problems reported. Eventually all institutions that receive federal funding will eventually follow all of the same rules set forward by the DOJ.
- HDRS is available on the web page, and the safe UT app can be used to report.
- Bond is coming up for election in Nov. 16 schools rebuild and remodel CHS is one of them
- Meeting with all legislature with our cones will have each community council bring questions to the table. Questions will be given beforehand. Meeting should take place in January. With all of these cones it encompasses 4 legislative districts. One idea in this is to help with the teacher load.

### Chris Keime

- School Dashboard Items Discussion  
Attachment was sent-Chronic absentee rate, rule violations and behaviors in students, teachers and retention at CHS and a comparative to other schools in the district. frequency and type of Safe UT tips, teacher satisfaction will be the ones that are focused on for right now.

- School Budget Overview  
A budget advisory committee is needed. An overview of the budget given by the district was reviewed. Custodial supplies, Instructional, Library and Media supplies, Textbooks and school repairs were shown.
- Land Trust and TSSP Budget Updates  
We got about 10% more TSSP and that is based on enrollment.
- Update on tour that was taken of CHS by Ben Kotter- things that are failing and not meeting the needs of the students. New equipment cannot be used because of lack of power. How can we best use \$30 million for CHS. Rebuild for CHS isn't in the near future so items that need to be fixed need to be prioritized. Proposal- brand new CTE/fine arts building in lot 1. Making and investment in students that may not want to go to a 4 year college. Businesses are also invested in this. Fall of 2025 would be hopefully when this would be started. If the bond passes we should be watching for renderings of a design by the end of the school year. In the next bond... new commons, a new wing hopefully new bond would come in 2027 or 28.
