

SUBJECT: BOARD OF EDUCATION MEMBERS: QUALIFICATIONS

A Board of Education member of the Churchville-Chili Central School District must meet the following qualifications:

- a) A citizen of the United States;
- b) Eighteen (18) years of age or older, and not a convicted felon or adjudged incompetent;
- c) Able to read and write;
- d) A legal resident for a continuous and uninterrupted period of one (1) year prior to the election;
- e) Cannot be an employee of the Churchville-Chili Central School District;
- f) The only member of his/her family (that is, cannot be a member of the same household) on the Churchville-Chili Central School District Board;
- g) May not simultaneously hold another incompatible public office, including, but not limited to Superintendent, clerk, tax collector, treasurer or librarian, or an employee of the Board.
 - 1) However, a Board member may be appointed clerk of the Board and of the District.
 - 2) A Board member of a BOCES may not be employed by any of that BOCES' component districts.
- h) Must not have been removed from a school district office within one year preceding the date of election to the Board.
