Budget Perspective


- Draft estimates received for the Raleigh Hills Replacement project.
 - o Both estimates are over target budget; the cost estimates include significant margins for market conditions.
 - Because of this, we will be moving to a CM/GC-delivery model.
- We received bids for the Sato classroom addition. At \$2.63M, the cost is right on track with the budget.
- 2022 Bond salaries will be reported on a quarterly basis.

Schedule Perspective

- Skanska awarded contractor manager/general contractor for the Beaverton High School Replacement project.
- Raleigh Hills design development 03/23 and construction development 10/23.
- Principal interviews scheduled for nine schools in October for school modernization.
- We have selected GM/GC partners for 2 substantial projects next summer:
 - Aloha HS Office Relocation Howard S. Wright Construction
 - Five Oaks Seismic & Roof Replacement P&C Construction

Challenges and Opportunities

- Washington County stated the Aloha HS Office Relocation project would be a Type 1. The county recommended that the design team stay under square footage thresholds that would result in it becoming a Type 2.
- The contract for the high school card readers will be held until the Security Audit has been completed.

Five Oaks Seismic


BSD's goal is to complete a structural evaluation of Five Oaks Middle School. This means designing new structural elements at the footing, wall and roof level to increase the building's ability to withstand a seismic event, per the District's goals.

- The District will negotiate a guaranteed maximum price within a couple of months.
- Main goal: Replace the roof, which has been leaking.
- The project is currently in the Design Development phase, and CIDA Architects should be issuing design development drawings on November 7.
- Reviewing existing conditions with the design team in October and will be issuing their schematic design cost estimate.





Devices

- The District is replacing the devices that the students currently have.
 - Students grades 3-12 have access to devices that they can keep at school or take home; 1:1 computer-to-student ratio.
 - Need to replace about 40,000 devices.
