Students are seen, celebrated and supported to achieve at the highest levels possible.

- Restorative Justice We take a community-based approach to discipline by building belonging for every child. When harm is caused, we use RJ practices to repair and restore relationships in our community.
- Crew—Students are part of a crew, a small group advisory focused on building relationships, reflecting on academic progress, and character development.
- Equity—We take a holistic view of each student and see their unique set of talents and experiences as assets. We are committed to being a culturally-responsive, anti-racist and anti-bias organization.

HANDS-ON LEARNING MODEL

As an EL Education school, we are committed to developing the **whole child** by supporting growth across three dimensions of student achievement: **Mastery of Knowledge and Skills, High-Quality Work, and Character**. Learning expeditions engage students in original research, critical thinking, and problem-solving to build character and academic skills. Expedition topics have included Food Justice, Disrupting Gun Violence and Civil Rights.

FREE AFTER-SCHOOL PROGRAMS + ENRICHMENT

- In collaboration with our long-time partners at Good Shepherd Services, Launch provides free after-school program 3:00 pm - 5:30 pm daily.
