Student Drivers

Students must have written permission from their parents to drive a motor vehicle (including Motorcycles) on campus. A vehicle registration form and contract agreement is available in the office. The vehicle must be parked in a regular parking space for students, locked and not entered during school hours unless special permission has been granted by administrator or office personnel.

Student vehicles parked on campus may be searched as determined appropriate by the administration.

1. All students driving on campus are to follow the correct traffic flow and to drive 5-10 MPH on campus at all times.
2. Students may never park on the street or enter the campus via 71st Street. If exiting onto 71st Street, students must always turn right.
3. Student drivers must always yield right of way to pedestrians on campus.
4. There will be no painting of parking spaces.
5. Students may not begin parking on campus until this permission form, signed by the student and at least one parent, is turning into the office.
6. Vehicles may be towed if determined appropriate by the administration.
7. The student bears full responsibility for the well-being of their family's vehicle. The school is not responsible for vehicles parked on campus.
