In The Classroom

Pre-K

Pre-k has been talking about "Marvelous Me." We explored what makes us unique and special in our own way. We also learned about the letters Gg and Oo and used our kinesthetic skills to make the letters with playdough and traced them. We also used auditory skills to listen for words beginning with the sounds of the letter. We also talked about how we are growing and changing. We are learning about lengths and using cubes to measure how long something is as well as using our arms to demonstrate how long an object is.

Kinder

Short week packed with fun and learning and love with Choose Love Lessons with Mrs. Owens! We dove into phonics learning consonants Dd and Nn along with their sounds, sight words: man, no, is and identified beginning sounds and rhyming words. In Reading, we had such fun reading Naked Mole Rat Gets Dressed and Pete the Cat: Too Cool For School. In Math, we continued composing and decomposing numbers 6-10 by making trains with students. In Science, we discovered sound energy. Social Studies we talked about location relevant to us and things in our school. Writing gave us the opportunity to write about a crazy costume! A lot of learning but also a lot of fun had by all!

1st

We are back from our two days off and started learning right away! We are adding numbers up to 20 in Math and studying good citizens from History in Social Studies. This week we are reviewing past sight words and preparing to take our Reading Module Test. In Writing, we are publishing and sharing our stories about our Wonderful School. It's a busy week for 1st Grade students!

2nd

Second grade had a great short week! In math we started learning about 2 digit addition with and without regrouping. In science we move into learning about sound energy. In ELAR we have been reviewing and testing.




3rd

In 3rd Grade math students have begun to determine the area of rectangles. Students are learning that area can be found anywhere, and apply it to our everyday lives. In Science we are focusing on Light and Sound Energy this week. We will being to wrap up all forms of energy, and moving towards how that energy effects force and motion. Elar is getting ready to take the next round of CBA's for the 2nd 6 weeks over poetry, and fictional texts. In Social studies, students are studying about Christopher Columbus and why his exploration shaped our World.

Lifeskills

In LifeSkills we have been focused on rhyming words and alliteration. We have used Dr. Seuss books such as Green Eggs and Ham, Horton Hears a Who, and One Fish Two Fish. We have also worked on teamwork during craft time and created bracelets for the students. Student led brainstorming for words that start with H.

This will be the final week with my first set of students. We will be reviewing past concepts, playing instruments, singing, and having a special earned music game day.



Art

In ART, our PreK/K students are learning about primary/secondary colors by creating rainbows. 1st grader are using playdough to make spiders to trace and color. Our 2nd/3rd graders are using pumpkins using different patterns and adding them to backgrounds of their choice.

STEM

Stem class focused on how water makes things grow. We experimented with water marbles and watched them grow more and more throughout class. We also made snowballs in the classroom using instant snow.




PE
