

School Attorney/Legal Services

The Board recognizes that the increasing complexities of school district operations frequently require professional legal services. Therefore, it shall retain competent attorneys or law firms to provide such services. The attorney or law firm shall serve at the pleasure of the Board and shall be compensated for services as determined by the Board.

A decision to seek legal advice or assistance shall originate from the Board, the superintendent or persons specifically authorized by the Board or superintendent. The attorney may be required to attend Board meetings or other meetings where legal services may be needed.
