In recognition of the need for continuing in-service training and development for its members, the Board encourages members to participate in meetings and activities of area, state and national school boards associations as well as in the activities of other educational groups. Board members are encouraged to study and examine materials received from these organizations as well as publications and tapes available in the Board's own library.

To help members develop an understanding of the educational program, the superintendent shall request members of the professional staff to appear before the Board from time to time to present and discuss new developments in various areas of curriculum and instruction.

The Board shall review conference attendance in developing the district budget for the succeeding year.
