Our academic approach is enhanced by an interdisciplinary philosophy that encourages the integration of creative thinking skills, and fosters the development of extraordinary leaders, thinkers, problem solvers and world changers.

Oxbridge Academy generously awards a wide range of competitive financial aid packages to eligible students. The partial or full tuition awards range from **\$5,000 to \$32,000** per year. Close to 50% of students from the graduating class of 2021 received financial aid; and 42% from the Class of 2022 are eligible to receive financial aid to date.

FACULTY

Oxbridge Academy is dedicated to promoting standards of excellence for teacher performance and student achievement. Over 75% of staff have an advanced degree, with 13% holding a doctorate. Our superior faculty leads student learning to meet and exceed state and national achievement standards. Oxbridge's specialized services include four full-time college counselors, three full-time learning support specialists, an on-site mental health counselor and a fully-staffed Physical Therapy and Wellness Center.

SIGNATURE PROGRAMS

Oxbridge Academy's *Signature Programs* ignite students' inner passion, strengthen individual skills, and provide valuable learning experiences; stimulating creative thinking and uniquely preparing students for college and beyond. Students have the opportunity to participate in the following programs:

FREE ENTERPRISE INSTITUTE Established in Fall 2022, this program provides a support system for those students interested in entrepeneurship, financial markets and product design. Students may attend guest lectures from distinguished speakers and are encouraged to participate in rigorous competitions and internships throughout the year.

ARTIFICIAL INTELLIGENCE Students are introduced to the Python programming language and learn through the intersection of computer science and mathematics. This program integrates concepts from calculus, statistics, linear algebra, and introduces the fundamentals of artificial intelligence and applies these concepts to real world scenarios.

AVIATION Students participate in hands - on activities designed by the Aircraft Owners and Pilots Association (AOPA) and their instructors to explore the physics and science of flying. Students learn in a full motion Redbird MCX Flight Simulator and participate in real-world "ground school" activities. Over a four-year program, students prepare to enter the world of aviation, engineering or any other career in the field.

CAMBRIDGE SCHOLARS This highly competitive interdisciplinary program is available to students in junior year who have demonstrated academic excellence. Chosen from a large pool of applicants, only 15 students are chosen to experience a two-week stay at the University of Cambridge in England where students meet faculty, participate in lectures and discussions, and write a college level essay. Successful students prepare and defend their work in front of Cambridge professors for academic credit and a grade.

INDEPENDENT RESEARCH AND STUDY Oxbridge students can independently explore and conduct research projects in collaboration with faculty and prestigious organizations, such as Scripps Florida, The Max Planck Institute, Ecology Project International, and Florida Oceanographic Society. This program provides students the opportunity to create their own curriculum and take on real-world initiatives. Past students have launched successful business, created immersive art-installations, and designed eco-friendly tiny homes.

CURRICULUM

Oxbridge Academy offers courses at the Regular, and Honors Seminar levels. The Honors, Honors Seminar curriculum is equivalent to or beyond the standards of Advanced aoes Placement[®] curriculum. These courses in any academic discipline are the most rigorous courses offered and are only available to those who have proven mastery in Honors level courses.

GRADING



Oxbridge Academy is semester-based and calculates weighted and unweighted GPAs for completed courses at the end of each semester.

Oxbridge Academy students are graded on the traditional 100-point scale, with Honors Seminar and Honors classes receiving a 5 and 3-point boost on the GPA, respectively. Only final course grades appear on our transcript, and students are not ranked.

Independent Study courses are graded pass/ fail. Students school credit receive high for completed coursework earned via the Dual Enrollment or through the Florida Virtual School Dual enrollment and Florida programs. Virtual School grades are not factored into the Oxbridge GPA. The Class of 2022 must complete 24 credits to earn an Oxbridge diploma.
