



Advanced Art Syllabus

Welcome to the art studio! I can't wait to see what we can create together.

Course Description:

This is a semester-long course for students who have successfully completed Beginning Art class. Having a solid foundation in art concepts, students will build on their previous knowledge, improving their skills and learning new, more complex techniques in visual art. Students will be learning Principles of Design; making connections between art and history and will be introduced to contemporary visual artists. Students will explore connections between personal life experiences and art.

During this course we will:

- Experiment with different art media and learning new techniques (printing, copper tooling, carving, brush strokes)
- Study and apply Principles of Design in an Artwork
- Using in-depth study of Art/Artist to develop appreciation for Art
- Creating, critiquing and presenting our works
- Have an opportunity to meet and learn about working artist (guest speaker)
- Visit Phoenix Art Museum (need parent-volunteers)

Materials needed:

- Sketchbook (you may use the one from last year if you still have it)
- Pencils/eraser
- Black sharpies (4)
- A ziplock for art supplies
- You may bring your own canvas if you wish
