BY PRINCIPAL COLEMAN

We are excited about the increase of achievement at LIES and we credit the success to all stakeholders working together to P.U.S.H. Over the course of 1 year, we have much to celebrate as an Osprey family.

- We observed a 57.4% increase in students identified as gifted in academics and the fine arts.
- We increased at or above the district's math, reading, and science achievement growth (i.e., Math- increase of 6.1%, E.L.A.- increase of 4.3%, Science- increase of 14.8%).
- We renewed our culture and saw a 24% increase in our staff's retention rate and an 11% increase in our student population.

Our next level of pushing together focuses on our student's growth. As we empower our students to lead their learning, we will see an increase in the individual growth of our students and our overall school report card rating.
