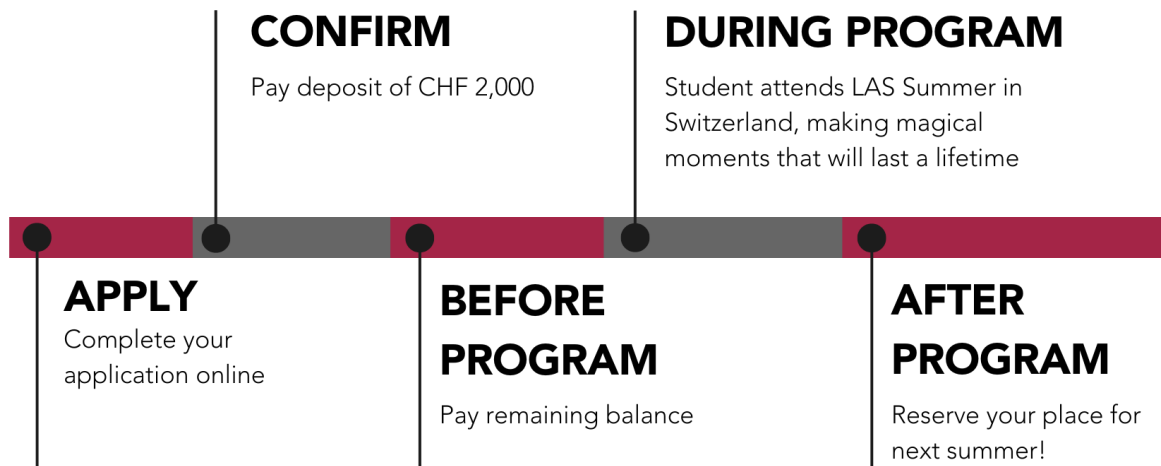




General Booking Conditions

Payment–Cancellation:

Acceptance to an LAS Summer in Switzerland program constitutes a contract to pay the entire tuition for the enrolled period. Accompanying the application is a deposit of CHF 2,000. The program (course and club selection, bed, etc.) is not reserved for your student until you pay the CHF 2,000 deposit. You must pay the remaining balance before the start of the program.



For applications received fewer than 30 days before the start of the program, we require full payment when the application is submitted to reserve a spot in the program for your student.

If you cancel, LAS will reimburse 100% of all fees if the cancellation is made 30 days before the program's start date. If it is less than 30 days before the start date of program, LAS will reimburse all fees if one or more of the following conditions apply:

- the student has received a positive COVID test within ten days of the program start date
- the student's flight was canceled within ten days of the program start date
- there is a border closure of Switzerland or the country of residence of the student
- there is a mandatory quarantine for the student upon arrival in Switzerland

If none of the conditions apply, LAS will reimburse 50% of the full program fee and 100% of the student's pocket money. The remaining 50% of the program fee may be transferred to enrollment during a future summer or academic year within two years.

There will be no reimbursement for late arrivals or early departures.

Fees Include:

Fees cover full room and board, regular instruction, use of computers, loan of required books, excursions, activities, certificate of completion (can be used for resumes or college applications), accident/health liability insurance coverage, and transfer to and from Geneva Airport on specified travel days. Fees do not cover transfers to and from Geneva Airport **any day other than specified travel days**, transfer to and from any other city, optional activities, dry cleaning, or similar expenses of a personal nature.

Medical:

Please complete the Health section of the Application Form carefully and accurately. Families must grant permission for COVID-19 testing (at the family's expense) and emergency medical or surgical treatments for their student (if deemed necessary by the medical staff of LAS Summer in Switzerland and the attending physician).

Please ensure that all information listed on the medical form is accurate. LAS Summer in Switzerland reserves the right to dismiss any student if the information therein is false or misleading.

Excursions:

Students may be given up to three hours of free time before a mandatory check-in with staff during some excursions. All students stay in groups of at least two and are encouraged to carry personal cell phones that work in Switzerland.

Programs:

If a class is oversubscribed, LAS Summer in Switzerland will open a waiting list. We process applications on a **first-come, first-served basis**. If there are insufficient numbers to run a class, LAS Summer in Switzerland will offer a substitute class at no extra cost. LAS Summer in Switzerland reserves the right to modify or make changes to the program listed on its website due to exigent circumstances.

LAS Summer in Switzerland Code of Behavior and Liability:

We ask that all students and families to read and adhere to our Student, Faculty, Staff, Family, and Visitor Pledge:

We recognize that all students, faculty, staff, families, and visitors must work together to ensure our community's safety. We ask that all community members adhere to the rules and regulations set out by LAS Summer in Switzerland. With this in mind, we pledge, as a community, to stay vigilant, exercise caution, and act responsibly while in Leysin and beyond the mountain.

At all times, students at LAS Summer in Switzerland must:

- Respect the cultural and social differences of their peers and mentors.
- Respect the school's property, the property of the local sports centers and businesses in Leysin, and the property of the sites visited on excursions.
- Respect the rules and norms of behavior in Switzerland, including quiet behavior between the hours of 22:00-08:00.

At no time may students at LAS Summer in Switzerland:

- Use tobacco products, including cigarettes, chewing tobacco, vape devices, and snuff. Students found smoking may be given a drug test.
- Use alcohol. Students found drinking will be sent home.
- Use illegal drugs, including marijuana. Students who do drugs will be sent home.
- Threaten another participant, whether student or staff, with physical or verbal violence and abuse. Students who threaten others will be sent home.
- Exhibit behavior contradictory to LAS's Diversity, Equity, and Inclusion practices including, but not limited to, racist, non-inclusive, or discriminatory behavior of any kind. Students exhibiting these behaviors will be sent home.

Failure to adhere to the LAS Summer in Switzerland Code of Behavior will result in disciplinary action, including immediate dismissal from the program at the family's expense.

An unsatisfactory discipline record from the previous summer may result in non-acceptance for a future summer.

Leysin American School reserves the right to ask a student to withdraw at any time. If a student proves to be an unsatisfactory member of the LAS Summer in Switzerland community, LAS reserves the right to withdraw the student from our program, even if there is no specific infraction. If a student is asked to leave the program, LAS Summer in Switzerland retains the entire payment. Additional costs related to withdrawal from the program—including but not limited to fees incurred for changing plane tickets and transport to the airport—are the family's responsibility. LAS Summer in Switzerland reserves the right to withdraw a student with no refund for providing false or incomplete information.
