Samsung American Legion Scholarship

Every year, \$300,000 in Samsung American Legion Scholarships are awarded to nearly 100 American Legion Boys State or American Legion Auxiliary Girls State participants. These scholarships are for undergraduate study only and may be used for tuition, books, fees, room, and board.

Scholarship applications are restricted to those who:

- attend the current session of either The American Legion Boys State or American Legion Auxiliary Girls State program

- AND are a direct descendant (i.e. child, grandchild, great-grandchild, or legally adopted child) of a U.S. military veteran who served on active duty during the periods designated as eligibility dates for membership in The American Legion.

Applicants who are direct descendants of Korean War Era Veterans will receive 3 bonus points.

Applicants with membership in the American Legion Auxiliary or Sons of the American Legion will receive a Bonus point; OR, they can receive a bonus point by uploading a membership card of a parent. No more than one bonus point for an application.

Scholarship winners are selected based on academic record, involvement in school and community activities, community service, and financial need.
