# **Please Donate New or Gently Used Coats**



# Safety and Security at OLGC

OLGC recently made some changes to the campus to upgrade and improve security. You will notice bollards in front of the school entrances, and new entrance and interior doors. We have a new entry system that will help us monitor better who is on campus at any given time. We are also installing more cameras to monitor who is on the campus.

One of the major changes is the new control access system put in place to make all of our buildings more secure. The key cards that many ministry leaders and outside organizations have been using no longer work, and new key fobs will be issued to those who need access to the buildings for scheduled events. With the new system, not everyone will need a key fob.

As with most new systems, it will take some time to fully transition. We ask for your patience as we adjust to the new procedures that are required by the Diocese to ensure that all children and adults on our campus can participate in the life of the school and church in safety.







**NEW TRIP** – You're going to want to register early for this very special trip to the Lewis Ginter Botanical GardenFest of Lights in Richmond, Virginia on Monday, December 5 from 1-9 pm. Vienna Parks & Recreation has planned an afternoon tour led by trained Garden guides which includes indoor displays such as the Train Room and the Library featuring magnificent holiday trees decorated with handcrafted garden botanical ornaments. You'll get to view breathtaking plantings and special holiday displays, including a towering live Christmas tree in the Conservatory. At dusk, take in the festively-illuminated garden and lakeside pathways among the outdoor displays of lights—over half a million of them! The time you spend here will surely get you in the holiday spirit. A buffet dinner is included in the trip fee which is \$92 for Vienna town residents, \$115 for everyone else. The day will involve a significant amount of walking, both indoors and out, so wear comfortable shoes. This is a charter trip with City of Fairfax Young at Heart Senior Center.

I've made this trip more than once and can tell you that it's quite an experience. The Lewis Ginter Botanical Garden is a treasure, quite large, seasonally beautiful but absolutely amazing during the Christmas holidays. There are themed gardens with gorgeous specimens of trees and shrubs. The Conservatory holiday display will take your breath away, as will the entire grounds which will be transformed into a fairyland with beautiful light displays. The buffet dinner is held in a lovely dining room, and I remember the food was quite good. In addition, they have a garden shop and a gift shop that feature unique, high-quality items at decent prices. If I had to pick one trip out of the whole year, this would be it! 


