Report," instead of the traditional Annual
Report. By sharing our donors' stories
and illustrating the impact of each dollar,
we celebrate the ways in which this
community lifts up the Day School.

The 2021–2022 academic year was of particular importance in the history of St. Patrick's, as Peter Barrett's twenty-eight year tenure as Head of School came to a close. He made innumerable contributions to the lives of thousands of students and their families in a career that culminated in his decisive leadership during the pandemic.

I remain incredibly grateful to past parents Blair Giannini and Jill Wiley White who led the charge in celebrating Peter's remarkable tenure. They assembled a terrific group of volunteers to orchestrate the Service of Celebration at the Washington National Cathedral, A Lasting Legacy Gala, and the Sustaining Excellence endowment fundraising in honor of Peter. We are so thankful to all who attended the events, submitted memories and well wishes, or made a gift to the endowment to support access, inclusion, and financial sustainability at the Day School.

In the same year, we began to welcome, and get to know, our incoming Head of School Jalene Spain Thomas. After a thorough search process, it was a joy for me to see the community's enthusiastic response to Jalene at her introductory Town Hall. She spent the second half of the year increasing her on-campus presence by attending Day School events and Middle School sports games. Behind the scenes, Jalene slowly

integrated into leadership by meeting monthly with her Transition Committee, which has representation from the Board of Trustees, Administration, Faculty, and the Parish. Peter and Jalene also met throughout the year to allow for her smooth transition. It has been a collective effort to onboard a new Head of School and I am impressed, but not surprised, by the teamwork and willingness of those involved.

The following report illustrates the strength of our generous community. Our traditional fundraisers, the Annual Fund and IDEALS, raised 7% of our operating revenue, providing critical support to enhance the program for our students and provide funds to ensure missionbased priorities like socioeconomic diversity. This year, our community went above and beyond their typical generosity to also make a significant impact on the endowment in honor of Peter. This is evidence of our families rallying around, with dedication and commitment, not only Peter but each other and future Day School families. Truly a mark of altruism characteristic of our donors.

Harv Lester and Don McMinn served admirably as Annual Fund Co-Chairs anchored by their motivational theme, Engage, Inspire, Dream. The Annual Fund is our top philanthropic priority and the second-largest income stream after tuition dollars. The Lester McMinns and their Leadership Council encouraged more than 600 community members to make \$1.2 million in gifts to the Day School. The Board of Trustees and faculty and staff, 100% of whom made an Annual Fund gift, set the bar high for other donors. 92% of our current parents answered the call to give generously to support our students and our faculty and staff as they strived to create a dynamic and supportive school environment amidst the continuing challenges of the pandemic.

Please join me in thanking the Fund-A-Scholar IDEALS Auction Co-Chairs, Elizabeth Engel, Shannon Powell McCarter, and Tashia Senn-Jones, who capably negotiated pandemic challenges to steer the course of an in-person Auction reminiscent of Auctions past in late April rather than early March. As we embraced Bouncing Back to the '90s, the Day School community was thrilled to gather together to celebrate our IDEALS (Inclusion, Diversity, Excellence, Agency, Learning, and Scholarship). The tribute to Peter at his last Auction as Head of School brought the room to its feet for a lengthy standing ovation. Incredible generosity from the bidders and donors to Fund-A-Scholar was strong evidence that Wolfhounds live out their values. Thanks to a true dedication to socioeconomic diversity, \$448,000 was raised to help students from a broad range of financial circumstances benefit from an excellent education. Another record-setting Fund-A-Scholar paddle-raise of \$407,575 helped fuel this success.

We deeply appreciate the contributions each member of our special community makes to create an extraordinary school and supportive environment for our students. We truly couldn't accomplish such important work without you. Thank you so much for all of your individual and collective contributions to making St. Patrick's a vibrant learning environment, particularly during these challenging times. I look forward to another opportunity for our community to come together in support of the Day School, our students, and our faculty and staff in the 2022-2023 school year!



The addition of a second full-time school counselor to support students' social-emotional growth and well-being.

Robust staffing in homeroom, learning specialist, and specialsubject settings to create the most effective environments for teaching and learning for all of our students.

Training faculty members, using theories from Elena Aguilar's The Art of Coaching, to become growth mentors for other faculty members.

The growth of parent/student/ faculty affinity groups across campus for members of the school community from Jewish, Latinx, Spanish-speaking, Asian, and African-American backgrounds. Affinity groups provide a space for students and families to explore their own identities and connect with others with whom they identify.

The addition of a fully equipped shed supports our teachers' garden curriculum and allows more students to enjoy and learn in our Garden & Outdoor Learning Space.

An ongoing commitment to keeping a St. Patrick's education within reach of families of various economic circumstances by minimizing tuition increases and helping to robustly fund a Financial Aid Program that provides assistance to 25% of our student body.



HOW YOUR GIFTS HAVE IMPACTED LIVES

As part of our mission to create a socioeconomically diverse learning community, St. Patrick's is committed to providing the opportunity for students from various economic circumstances to attend the Day School. Your gifts make this reality possible, and we are deeply grateful.

Included here is the story of one of our many exceptional alumni who were beneficiaries of the Financial Aid Program.

Clinton James joined the Infant Toddler Center at St. Patrick's when he was only a few months old and left in 2006, after completing his Grade 8 year. He went on to attend St. Andrew's Episcopal School and later earned a bachelor's degree in history and secondary education with a minor in political science from Longwood University. Committed to the field of education and student. advancement, he also earned a master's degree in educational leadership and policy studies from the University of Richmond, while working as a 6th grade US history teacher at Sussex Central Middle School in 2019. Today, Clinton is the Assistant Principal at Sussex Central Middle School, and he is happily married to his wife, Rachel, with one son, Carty. He has already taken the first step in his educational leadership journey.

What impact do you think St. Patrick's had on your life?

"St. Patrick's gave me a solid foundation on which I built the rest of my life. My teachers were always warm and welcoming and they gave me all the attention and time that I needed to succeed. School was not always easy for me and although I may not have appreciated the extra care I was given at the time, I now see how crucial it was to my development. The stronger your foundation, the higher you go, and I clearly see the impact that St. Patrick's continues to have on me until this day."

Why did you choose to go into education?

"I had always worked with children. I helped out with the summer program at St. Patrick's for several years, where I was a counselor in training and, later, a classroom teacher. I also really appreciated the dedication I saw in my teachers and the impact that had on their students. Both my parents are educators as well so, in the end, it just made sense."

What is your favorite memory of St. Patrick's?

"I have so many great memories of St. Patrick's! I actually can't remember a



single negative one. My favorite one might have to be the Kindergarten Circus. I got to smash a pie in the Head of Middle School's face! I still smile when I remember that."

Why do you think that gifts to support financial aid are important?

"Diversity and diverse viewpoints matter. Bringing this into the classroom is crucial, and sharing different experiences and perspectives is so important to communities and to child development. Financial aid gives children from different backgrounds the opportunity to attend St. Patrick's, an opportunity that would otherwise not be available to them. On the one hand, you're helping give those children a solid foundation and setting them up for future success and, on the other hand, you're bringing diversity into the school and into the classroom. It's a win-win situation for everyone, and, with those gifts, you're potentially changing the trajectory of people's lives (and arguably the world) for the better."






