Schedule

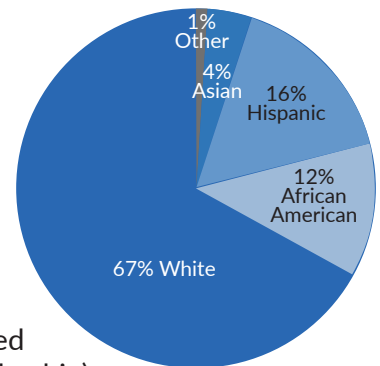
