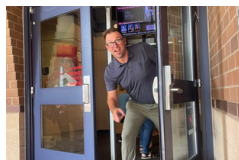

Our staff has been working tirelessly prepping for our kids to have their most epic school year. Please consider thanking our office dynamic duo of Kirstin & Heidi, they epitomize PV Pride in all they do--*real* marvels.



During our professional development days we explored collective efficacy and reiterated the importance of believing in one another--as Ted Lasso would say, "Believe in believe." I believe we at PV are equipped to love, know, and develop our kids and community. Let's fly! Together.

I hope many of your questions can be answered here in order to feel ready for "Opening Day"!

Day one and beyond, we love to greet our students and get them all lined up for their classes. Morning line-up [[HERE](#)] is organized by class location with big signs labeled by teacher. We ask that students aren't playing on the equipment in the mornings, because we do not have the necessary supervision available. Students are able to begin lining up 10 minutes before school starts, so 8:50am every day our first week of school.


Students can access breakfast 15 minutes prior to school's start. On M, T, TH, F, they can get started at 8:45am and on late start Wednesdays (starting week 2) at 9:25am. Click [HERE](#) for more information on school meals. Typical school hours are 9:00am - 3:20pm on Monday, Tuesday, Thursday, and Fridays. Late start Wednesdays start at 9:40am to allow our teachers to collaborate on how to best serve your kids. Again, this doesn't start until week 2. These professional learning communities (PLC) are run very intentionally to "see" our kids and to achieve our vision to build capacity in one another to love, know, and develop your child. We will position ALL students to be future ready--equipped and empowered to dream, believe, and achieve.

Finally, in order to ensure the safest school possible, all visitors check in through the front desk. That also means that students are dropped off at their respective line and not escorted all the way to their classrooms. Throughout the year, ALL guests check in through the front desk. We believe "safety doesn't happen by accident" and your child's safety is paramount. Want to volunteer? Check in with your child's teacher about their needs then head [HERE](#) to get cleared for the year. All volunteers are checked centrally in Mead.
