Our Mission

The American Overseas School of Rome (AOSR) offers the best of an American-International education in a supportive learning environment. We inspire a diverse student body to courageously meet the demands of a changing world through an engaging and creative curriculum.

Our Curriculum

The school year runs from September to June, divided into two semesters for the high school. AOSR offers a rigorous curriculum, including AP and IB classes, taught by a highly educated faculty. 85% of our staff hold advanced degrees, 75% are from English speaking countries (another 18% is from Italy), and 100% of our IB/AP faculty are trained subject area experts. We have been an IB World School since 1989 and we were the first AP School in Italy. AOSR is fully accredited by the Middle States Association of Colleges and Schools and was the first school to be awarded MSA's prestigious International Credential. We are also members of CIS, ECIS, and RISA. AOSR does not rank students. GPAs are calculated using all courses taken at AOSR. IB, AP, and select advanced courses are given an additional weight of 0.5 towards the cumulative GPA.

Our School

Founded in 1947, the American Overseas School of Rome is a private, non-profit, coeducational day school. The school is located on a beautiful seven-acre campus north of the historic center of Rome, Italy. We are a vibrant, open-minded, and caring community of 570 K-12 students (64 students currently in Grade 12) from 52 different countries. Our parent community has a strong PTO that sponsors 9 community events throughout the year.

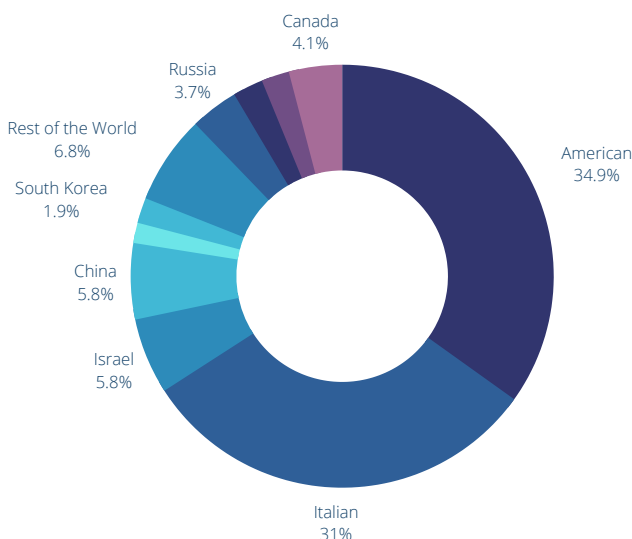
Our Activities

Students are involved in a vast array of athletics, arts, travel, service, academic competitions, and clubs. AOSR offers 9 student leadership clubs and organizations. We have 5 varsity sports teams, including volleyball, basketball, soccer, cheerleading, and cross country. Our school offers educational trips to Europe each year. Our performing arts department produces 15 concerts, theater productions, and art exhibitions annually. We also have an extensive service learning program.

Pandemic Update

AOSR was closed from March 2020 and remained closed for the rest of that school year. Classes were held online during the closure and graduation was also held online. For most of the 2021-22 school year, students were on campus on alternate days. Where there were positive Covid cases, certain classes moved to online learning for a maximum of 2 weeks. In the 2021-22 school year, we were able to hold graduation on campus. School reopened in September 2022 and so far this year we have been able to remain open.

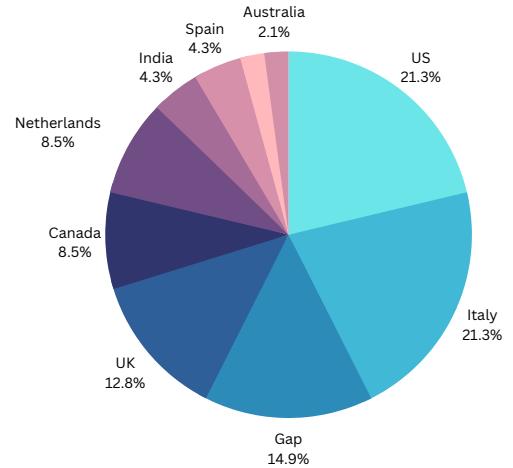

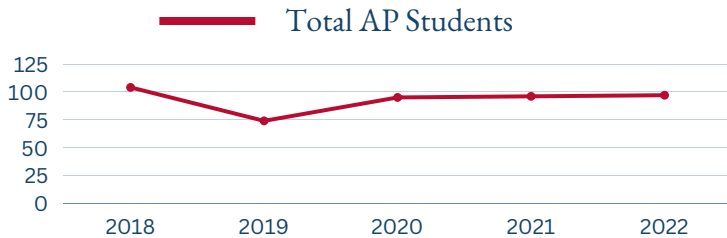

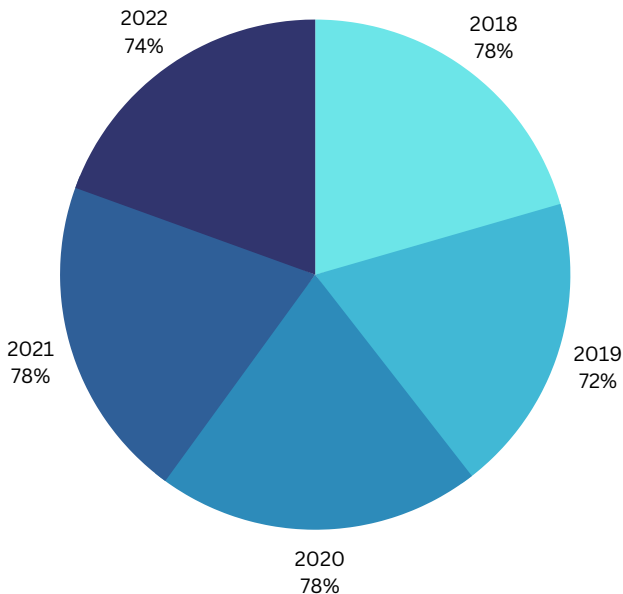
