## Emergency Protocol

In most cases, the evacuation of a school building is a temporary matter. In these cases, all students and building personnel exit their building and congregate in designated areas until they are authorized for re-entry.

In the event of an emergency or disaster occurring in our area, the Burrell School District, in conjunction with the Lower Burrell Police and Fire Departments, has developed a plan to reunite students with their families.

If an emergency or disaster situation occurs while school is in session, please help us care for all students:

- \* *Please Remain Calm*
- \* ***DO NOT call the school*** (it is important to keep home and school lines open). *Edline and the Emergency Phone Contact System (School Messenger) will provide information to all parents/guardians*

## TRANSPORTATION

Students will be transported to the reunification site unless the incident occurs at dismissal time. If the incident occurs at dismissal time, the students will be transported home. You will receive information and instructions via Edline and the Emergency Phone Contact System. If normally required, transportation for students with handicapping conditions will be provided.

If you are instructed to pick up your child:

1. Please bring I.D.
2. Check-in with school officials
3. A staff member will unite you with your child
4. Please make sure you sign your child(ren) out as dismissed
5. Promptly leave the reunification site's grounds

The success of the plan depends on your cooperation. Please take a moment to familiarize yourself and your family with this emergency plan.
