



DISASTER CRISIS OUTREACH AND REFERRAL TEAM

Who is DCORT?

DCORT stands for Disaster Crisis Outreach and Referral Team.

DCORT members are trained crisis outreach responders led by a local county DCORT Coordinator in charge of Emergency Behavioral Health.

They provide services to persons impacted by disaster events, natural or manmade.

Disaster events may include but are not limited to things like:

- Fires/Car accidents
- Natural Disasters
- Pandemic Events

DCORT is coordinated by:
Westmoreland County
Behavioral Health and Developmental Services

Where would DCORT deploy?

DCORT can deploy to:

- Disaster Recovery Centers (DRC)
- Emergency Operation Centers (EOC) if asked
- Community
- Shelters
- Schools
- Accident and fire events if requested
- Exercises and drills



What would DCORT do?

DCORT would:

- Provide outreach in the community, at shelters, in Disaster Recovery Centers, and local events
- Assist in assessing the impact of disasters and work in the Incident Command Structure to provide support or referral
- Assess psychological impact of incidents
- Provide support, education and referral assistance
