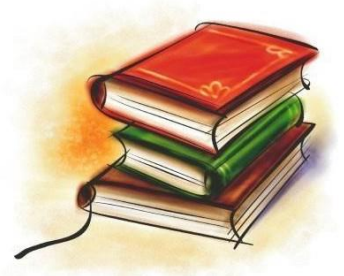


Accelerated Reader Burrell School District



Students in grades K-3 at Bon Air Elementary use the Renaissance Learning Accelerated Reader program, a web-based supplemental reading program that helps students to increase their comprehension and allows a child's learning team to gather valuable data about the child as a reader.

- Kindergarten students who are ready to begin Accelerated Reader start during the second semester and use the program to enhance their emerging reader skills.
- Students in grades 1-3 use the program to build and practice reading skills.

Accelerated Reader Incentive Program for Bon Air Elementary

In addition to the classroom applications, an incentive program is supported by the PTA at Bon Air to encourage and assist students in becoming proficient readers and to help foster a life-long love of reading. Students can test on books that they read and earn points towards incentives.

Parents and Accelerated Reader

- Parents are provided with their child's username and password for the program, and can then access Home Connect to log in to monitor a student's AR progress by using this link:

- Testing can be done at home and at school Monday through Friday between 8:00 a.m. and 8:00 p.m.
- Kindergartners traditionally do not start Accelerated Reader until sometime in the second semester.
