DIRECTOR'S NOTES

We have to be a little crazy.

Once casting was completed for *The Tempest*, we had a month and a half to get this production in front of an audience. The cast needed to learn, understand, memorize, and convincingly communicate Shakespearian dialogue. The crew needed to build half a life-sized sailing ship, create special effects, meticulously plan light and sound cues, and create a fantastical world onstage. Our students and creative staff love to push our limits, but this year was especially intense.

There's a reason I call our Shakespeare productions "AP Theater." Everyone is required to do a great deal of work in a short time and the demands are steep. In the end, these challenges are well worth it. Performing Shakespeare forces actors and crew members to get VERY good at what they do VERY quickly. Our students have certainly surpassed my expectations and I am extraordinarily proud of them. If I am appreciative of anything regarding the past few years, it's that we've never compromised the standards of our performances. In fact, we've continued to push ourselves to always get better at what we do.

The Tempest itself is one of Shakespeare's comedies, though its story begins rather tragically. It is one of the final plays he wrote without partnering with another playwright. Themes of betrayal, reconciliation, vengeance, forgiveness, control, freedom, the supernatural, and reason intermingle to create a play of contrasts. It is these conflicting elements that we have tried to bring forth. There are moments of intense drama and moments of gut-punching hilarity, and we hope you experience a range of emotions throughout our show.


