

Rochester Public Schools District-Wide School Enrollment Application for 2023-2024



Siblings must apply to get sibling preference. If you completed a 22-23 application for this 23-24 school year, it will not rollover, if not selected during the 22-23 school year again, the application will not rollover. You must reapply in the 23-24 school year.

Check each of the District-Wide Option School programs that you are applying for. You do not need to rank in preference order, you will be included in all drawings that you select.

Please print clearly. Deadline to be included in the first drawing is midnight January 22nd, this drawing will include siblings. If siblings do not submit application to be included in first drawing, they will remain in pool for open space. The first initial drawing will only be for incoming kindergarten students, all other grade levels are drawn when and if space becomes available.

Families selected in the first initial drawing will be called sometime during the week of January 23rd. Please be patient, as our team will get through calls as quickly as possible.

Sibling applications must be in by midnight January 22nd, to be included in the first drawing. Siblings applying after January 22nd, will go into the lottery pool until space becomes available.
