

Picture Day FAQ

Q: If I forget my picture form and money at home, can my guardians still purchase my school pictures?

A: Yes. Guardians/students can order online at <https://lifetouch.com/> using the code provided.

Q: Do I have to take my school picture even if my guardians are not purchasing them?

A: Yes. These photos will be uploaded to My Backpack for internal student identification.

Q: I am a senior and have already had my pictures taken by a professional photographer. Do I still need to have school pictures taken?

A: Yes. Senior school pictures will also be uploaded to My Backpack for internal student identification. Photos may be used in the yearbook, for publication of scholarship recipients, and the wallboard composite representing the graduating class hanging in the hallway.

Q: I am a residential student and just had my photo taken for the WA Residential Student Directory. Do I still need to have my school picture taken?

A: Yes. Residential students' school pictures will be uploaded to My Backpack for internal student identification. Please encourage residential students to come to the cafe when their respective grades call them.

Q: If I take my photo today and don't like it, will there be a makeup school picture day for retakes?

A: Yes. There will be a makeup/retake day. Watch for announcements at school and on WA social media.

Please remind students to remove their hats and hoods for their photos.
