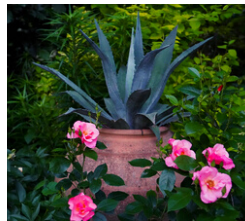
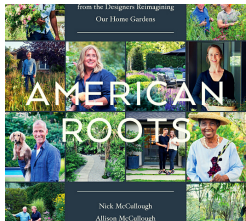
23RD CHANTICLEER LECTURE

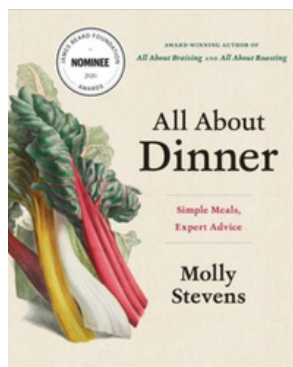
