

RACHEL'S LEGACY-THE POWER OF ONE-SCHOLARSHIP

To be eligible for this scholarship, you must be a high school senior that is college bound and graduating from Owatonna High School in June of 2015. The amount of the scholarship is \$500.00 and the recipient will be announced at the Academic and Scholarship Awards Banquet at Owatonna High School in May. A check for that amount will be made out to the student/college.

Rachel Scott was one of the students who lost her life at Columbine High School in Littleton, Colorado on April 20th, 1999. Since her death, Rachel's Legacy has traveled the United States and other countries to spread the message that Rachel embraced. With her life Rachel exemplified the power that any one person can have on the life of another; with her death the message has spread through junior and senior high schools that the power of one exists within us all.

Rachel's Legacy shares five basic principles that reflect **THE POWER OF ONE:**

- **APPRECIATE OTHERS**
- **RESPOND TO OTHERS**
- **INITIATE WITH OTHERS**
- **RESPECT OTHERS**
- **FORGIVE OTHERS**
