Student Behavior Support

The school setting is a place for students work on both academic and social skills. Students, as we all do, make mistakes from time to time. Mistakes provide us an opportunity to learn, reflect, and improve going forward. This is a natural part of growing up. Supporting students in these areas requires a partnership between home and school.

Recently we have seen an uptick in inappropriate student behaviors at school, which provides us with an opportunity to partner in this particular area. You can support us by having a conversation with your student about being respectful to teaching staff, appropriate in their interactions with other students, and mindful of the personal space of their peers. We also ask that parents evaluate what students are watching on TV or accessing via various forms of technology. The exposure that students have at home in terms of TV shows, video games, and social media can at times be a negative influence that fosters inappropriate and disrespectful behavior at school.

We have amazing students and want to make sure we are doing all we can to guide them as they mature. Your support in this area will have a positive impact on the school setting, ensuring that students have respectful interactions with staff and peers. Thank you for your partnership!

Attendance

Attached to this week's update is a letter from the district outlining LWSD's attendance policies. Please take a moment to review this letter so you are aware of these policies.

As a reminder, having your child attend school on a regular basis is crucial for their growth. In-person instruction cannot be replicated. As a result, we ask that parents do their best to minimize non-essential absences. We will periodically check attendance, sending home letters to students who have a combined 10% or more absentee/tardy rate. Absences excused due to illness will not be included when calculating the 10% threshold for school letters. Our first attendance letter reminders will be sent home on November 4th.

Volunteer Procedures - Changes

As of November 1st proof of COVID vaccination will no longer be required in order to volunteer at school. Standard background checks and volunteer applications will still be required.
