### **STUDENTS**

Charge: EC48262 = Habitual truant (Infraction)

Any or all of the following penalties:

1<sup>st</sup> offense = \$50 fine or 20 hours of community service

2<sup>nd</sup> offense = 24 hours of community service

Deny/revoke work permit

### **PARENTS**

Charge: EC48200 = Failure to compel attendance (Infraction)

Penalty:

1<sup>st</sup> offense = \$100 fine (EC48293)

2<sup>nd</sup> offense = \$250 fine (EC48293)

3<sup>rd</sup> offense = \$500 fine (EC48293)

### **Possible additional penalty to parents:**

EC48268 = a parent may be ordered to deliver student to school every day for the rest of the school term. (EC48638 for Opportunity Schools).

### **PC 272(a)(1) - Contributing to the delinquency of a minor (misdemeanor).**

Penalty = Probation terms, up to \$2,500 fine and/or up to 1 year in jail.

### **PC 270.1(a) - Parent of a chronic truant grades K - 8 (misdemeanor).**

Penalty = Probation terms, up to \$2,500 fine and/or up to 1 year in jail.

Cargo: EC48262 = Faltar a la clase regularmente (Infracción)

Cualquier o todas las siguientes penas:

1ª ofensa = Multa de \$50 o 20 horas de servicio a la comunidad

2ª ofensa = 24 horas de servicio a la comunidad

Revocar o no dar permiso de trabajo

## PADRES

Cargo: EC48200 = Falta de obedecer la ley de educación obligatoria (Infracción)

Castigo:

1ª ofensa = \$100 de multa (EC48293)

2ª ofensa = \$250 de multa (EC48293)

3ª ofensa = \$500 de multa (EC48293)

## Posible multas adicionales para los padres:

EC48268 = padres pueden ser obligados a llevar al estudiante a la escuela todos los días hasta fin del año escolar. (EC48638 para Escuelas Alternativas)

## CP 272(a)(1) - Contribución a la delincuencia de un menor (delito menor).

Castigo = Términos de libertad condicional hasta \$2,500 o 1 año de cárcel.

## CP 270.1(a) – Padre de un grado crónico de ausentismo K – 8 (delito menor).

Castigo = Términos de libertad condicional hasta \$2,500 o 1 año de cárcel.
