2022-2023 DISTRICT EDUCATION IMPROVEMENT COMMITTEE <u>AGENDA</u>

I. Curriculum & Instruction

• District Update – Dr. Allison Schaum and Mrs. Kenna Moody presented current topics and action items in the curriculum and instruction department. Topics discussed were the curriculum audit, TEKS RS – TexGuide, Assessments and STAAR 2.0, Special Programs including EB/ESL and GT, instructional resources, and professional development. The school year's initiative towards selecting a viable district curriculum will become a prevailing them entering into the spring semester.

II. District Improvement Plan (DIP)

o Approval of the 2022-2023 TMISD DIP – Dr. John White reviewed the current school district improvement plan, including this year's districtwide Title I status requirements. The review focused on the CNA, the four goals and strategies, specifically Parent and Family Engagement. Given the requirements for Title I, Dr. White suggested that a Title I Committee be formed, to which the committee agreed. The 2022-2023 TMISD DIP was approved by the DEIC, with no members opposed. The DIP will go to the School Board for approval at the regular meeting on Monday, October 17, 2022.

III. District Parent & Family Engagement (PFE) Policy

Discussion regarding the 2022-2023 TMISD PFE Policy – Dr. John White reviewed the requirements for the PFE Policy. The committee had opportunities to provide feedback on changes or updates to the policy. At this time, no changes to the policy were recommended. The suggestion of moving the PFE Policy to be one of the responsibilities for the Title I Committee was given consideration by the committee.

IV. District Equity Plan

Discussion regarding the TMISD Equity Plan – Dr. John White shared with the committee that the District Equity Plan – another Title I requirement – to be completed by the Title I Committee. Updates were provided on the required submission of the Equity Plan in school year 2023-2024. Updates focused on

closing equity gaps and the strategies that would overlap with the DIP or would act as a standalone.

V. District Title I Committee

O Discussion regarding the development of a TMISD Title I Committee – More Title I requirement information was shared by Dr. John White. Specifically, PFE meeting requirements and the need to develop a more focused plan on building parent capacity (adult learning). The committee recommended more consideration to the development of the committee and the process that will be used to select members. The process will follow or be very similar to the election process for the DEIC.
