



What is Educational Opportunity Fund (EOF)?

The New Jersey **Educational Opportunity Fund (EOF)** provides support services (e.g. counseling, tutoring, and developmental course work) and financial assistance to students from educationally and economically disadvantaged backgrounds who attend participating institutions of higher education in the State of New Jersey.

ELIGIBILITY

- Must demonstrate an educationally and economically disadvantaged background
- Must be a New Jersey resident 12 consecutive months prior to receiving the award
- Must apply and be accepted to a participating New Jersey college or university
- Must meet the academic criteria as set by the institution of choice
- Must file a Free Application for Federal Student Aid (FAFSA) or the New Jersey Alternative Financial Aid Application for NJ Dreamers - DACA Students.
- Gross income and assets must fall within the criteria shown:


PROXIMITY
