



Dilworth PTA Board Meeting Minutes

Thursday August 18, 7:30 PM

Welcome: Thanks to the new board for 2022-2023!

Business: All PTA board members must pay \$5 to be registered members.

At next month's meeting we will vote on the budget. We will not be making a monetary gift to the school this year. We gifted the school in April 2022. Due to two years of no fundraising we hope to build our budget to resume these gifts in the future.

PTA donation will probably remain as an option on registration.

Welcome breakfast for teachers and staff will be Friday August 26. Hospitality will need some help that morning setting up - approx 8:15 am.

Registration will be all online through MemberHub.

Yearbooks can be ordered at the beginning of the year. All staff and teachers will have one provided by the PTA. Yearbooks for every student will be ordered to ensure everyone has a yearbook.

New possible styles for apparel were circulated. No adult apparel will be ordered this year and the consensus seemed that both a t-shirt and hoodie option will be available.

Approximately 75 students qualify for assistance and Melissa Manville has come up with a fundraiser to help these children have a full school experience throughout the year by providing the following: yearbook, Valentine's, birthday treats, Halloween costume, Art Night vouchers, etc. Fundraiser at Sugarhouse Park on August 25. Free ice cream provided. These funds may be directed to Bethany Epstein or managed by PTA. The number of students qualifying for this assistance may increase after registration.

Dragon readers will begin in October with bookmarks for reading and the program promoted over social media. Presentations to kindergarten and first grade.

Dots for Dilworth will be the fall fundraiser. It will begin on September 12 and Toni Reeves will need volunteer help for stuffing envelopes and other tasks before, during and after the fundraiser.

It was suggested we bring back STEM night in February. This needs to be discussed with the activities committee. Not a fundraiser. Would coincide with science projects. Many board members suggested ideas for groups from the community to be involved.

GroupMe will be used as a communication app for the board. A poll will go out to see when it is best to hold monthly board meetings. Zoom was also suggested as an option.
