Strawberry Mango Italian Ice



Ingredients for 4 servings

- 1 ½ cups of fresh strawberries
- 1 ½ cups of fresh mango
- 1 tbs. fresh lime juice
- 3 to 4 tbs. honey

Preparation

1. Add all ingredients in a blender, leaving out half of the ice.
2. Blend until ice is broken up. Add remaining ice and blend until smooth.
3. Spread into ungreased 9" x 13" baking dish.
4. Freeze for 30 minutes.
5. Break up mixture with fork.
6. Freeze again at least two hours.
7. To serve, let set at room temperature until you can scoop out ice.
