Entrepreneur - a person who is willing to help launch a new venture or enterprise.

The William S. Little Scholarship is awarded to a graduating senior student who has worked or engaged in business enterprises during his/her school years, either after school or during vacations and has shown an **unusual** aptitude and initiative to earn money...***the student who has an entrepreneurial spirit.*** Financial need and grades will be considered, but they will not be the governing factors.

Additional criteria/information:

Scholarship is awarded to a young man or woman who wishes to further his/her education in an accredited four-year college or university.

Note: The application must be submitted through your school guidance office and when forwarded should be accompanied with your school transcripts (including Q1 senior grades) resume and optional letter of recommendation. Students have until March 21st to submit their applications to the guidance office. Each school is to email no more than four recommended finalists for the Scholarship Committee to select from. Please send each student in a separate file along with their documents.

Scholarship Renewals:

Scholarship is a renewable scholarship. Recipient MUST provide the Community Foundation of New Jersey required the required renewal documents by the July 15th deadline updating the Foundation on his/her just completed college school year. The narrative and additional required documents automatically make the recipient *eligible to be considered for a grant the following school year.*

Recipients must provide the following no later than July 15th deadline:

- 1) Transcript (Student must remain in good academic standing)
- 2) Resume
- 3) Proof of Full Time Enrollment (Enrolled on a full-time basis for the upcoming academic year, maybe on the transcript)
- 4) One page narrative (the student's past year's academic experience, details of work performed during the academic year, and any employment experience.
