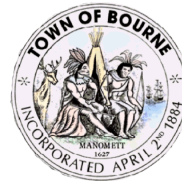

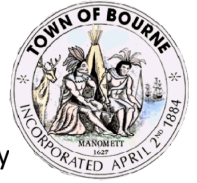

1. Update on PD to Date
  - a. RISE Training  
Around 50 staff members participated in RISE training with special education teachers and content teachers from each grade level. Focused on 4 areas of disability rather than specific disabilities, as well as a true co-teaching model in special education. Admin team trained on day 3. There will be two more days in November to complete the training.
  - b. UA Arts Curriculum Work: continued work on aligning UA curriculum vertically.
  - c. Data Team Refreshers  
BHS: Benchmark data sent to grade 9/10 math and ELA teachers to hone in on individual needs during WIN. In addition, five teachers met with Laurie Casna and discussed WIN and working on building a vision for data use beyond just test scores. Meets again 10/11.  
BMS: 5 teachers on the data team as well that support data literacy throughout the building and do most of the “busy” work regarding data to take that load off of teachers.  
BIS and BES: Teams have met with Laurie Casna. Worked on protocols for how to use data more effectively and efficiently. Teams now include teachers as well as administrators.
  - d. Math Workshop Preliminary Visit  
Allison Mello was in the district for two days and visited classrooms at BES and BIS (teachers participated voluntarily) in order to identify goals for future PD. She will be in the district for most PD days this year.
  - e. ALICE Training  
Part one of refresher training. Bourne PD worked with staff and next steps are to disseminate FAQ information to clarify and streamline procedures in each building.
  - f. OpSciEd Launch PD  
7th grade science teachers attended 4 days of PD and presented to remaining science teachers.
  - g. Investigating History Pilot  
Two 6th grade social studies teachers attended two days of PD over the summer with 4-6 additional days to come.
