

SECONDARY UNIFORM GUIDELINES

The BHS uniform creates a sense of belonging within the School as well as an identity for the School in the broader community. By wearing their uniform with pride and respect, BHS students demonstrate their commitment to the high standards of personal and professional behaviour which are the hallmark of a BHS education.

Year 7-11 Summer Uniform April 1st – December 1st

Skirt Bermuda Shorts Skort or Trousers	Navy skirts, skorts or Bermuda shorts - must be an appropriate length Navy trousers
Polo	White polo shirts with BHS logo embroidered on the left-hand side Light blue polo shirt with BHS logo [Year 11 prefects only] Note: Year 11 Prefects may wear their blue collared shirt and tie year-round instead.
Socks	Navy knee socks.
Shoes	Sensible brown or black leather shoes.
Sweater (optional)	A navy V-necked BHS pullover (Available only from the BHS School Shop)
¼ zip jacket(optional)	A BHS ¼ zip jacket (available from the BHS School Shop and Lands' End) may be worn for additional warmth

Year 7 - 11 Winter Uniform December 1st – March 31st

Skirt Bermuda Shorts Skort or Trousers	Navy skirts, skorts or Bermuda shorts - must be an appropriate length Navy trousers
Shirt	White short or long-sleeved shirt, button-down, traditional style with pointed collar with a BHS tie Blue shirt with BHS tie [Year 11 prefects only]
Socks	Navy knee socks or plain navy tights.
Tie	Presented to BHS students at their point of entry to Secondary Also available from the BHS School Shop or at Reception. Required for winter uniform and formal occasions
Shoes	Sensible brown or black leather shoes.
Sweater (optional) ¼ zip jacket (optional)	A navy V-necked BHS pullover (Available only from the BHS School Shop) or a A BHS ¼ zip jacket (available from the BHS School Shop or from Lands' End) may be worn under the blazer for additional warmth
Blazer	Navy blazer is required for the winter uniform and formal occasions. The BHS School logo is to be sewn on the left-hand side of the blazer (or embroidered if selecting the Lands' End option)

Additional Optional items

BHS Tracksuit - may be worn on Flexible Dress days (explained below), on PE days (if Covid regulations require students to come to school in their PE kit) and must be worn when representing the school during inter-school competition

BHS Hoodie - may only be worn to school on Flexible Dress days

BHS Long-sleeved top - may only be worn to school on Flexible Dress days and for PE activities at the teacher's discretion

BHS Active leggings- may only be worn to school on Flexible Dress days and for PE activities at the teacher's discretion

BHS baseball caps in house colours or navy

*** Please note: From September 1st, 2023, students will no longer be allowed to wear uniform items with the old BHS logo ***

PE KIT

The PE kit must be brought to school on PE days in a labelled PE bag or worn to school on PE days if required by Covid guidelines. If the latter, the BHS polo must be brought to school to change into after PE.

PE Kit all items clearly labelled	BHS T-shirt in the House colour BHS navy school shorts or skort Water bottle BHS Sports T-Shirt for team players, only if requested by the PE Department BHS Active leggings (optional - students must bring shorts to change into in case of indoor PE lesson) BHS Long-sleeved top (optional) BHS tracksuit (optional) White ankle socks (optional) BHS Baseball Cap (optional) BHS PE bags (optional) Sunscreen (highly recommended)
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Notes

Skirt / Skort sizing can be tricky. For those students with longer legs, who cannot size up due to the waist size, we suggest choosing the "slim" size option in the Lands' End website, which will have a smaller waist while still maintaining the length that we consider acceptable. Alternatively, a "below the knee" style may be selected.

All shirts must be tucked in at all times, including when students are not in school, in order to maintain a smart look.

Other uniform guidelines

Formal Uniform:

During formal occasions, such as the Torch Ceremony, Prize Giving and School Photograph Day, students will be required to wear a white collared shirt, a BHS tie and navy knee-length socks. A blazer is also required for formal occasions or when representing BHS, when it is weather-appropriate.

Hair, Jewellery and Makeup

At BHS, we aim to maintain a professional environment. Uniform expectations are graduated so that Secondary students have increasing flexibility as they become older. This being said, the expectation is that our students will dress appropriately and professionally, showing pride both in and outside of school whilst in BHS uniform.

Middle School

- Hair must be natural in colour and be worn with neutral or school-branded hair accessories. Hair must be tied back, fully off the shoulders
- Single pair of simple stud earrings, one in each ear; a watch and a simple neck chain; a single BHS or charity-related bracelet may be worn.
- All jewellery and watches must be taken off for PE lessons and fixtures
- No make-up, coloured nail polish or acrylic nails

Senior School

- Hair must be natural in colour and be worn with neutral or school-branded hair accessories. Hair must be tied back fully off the shoulders **for Science and PE lessons only.**
- Jewellery (earrings, chains, bracelets and rings) may be worn so long as it adheres to professional environment expectations. No hoops or dangly earrings are allowed for health and safety reasons. If in doubt, please check with the Head of Year
- All jewellery and watches must be taken off for PE lessons and fixtures.
- Light make-up and clear/ neutral nail polish are allowed; no acrylic nails.

Flexible Dress days

On these occasions, whether weekly or otherwise, students will be allowed to wear any BHS-branded item as a part of their uniform.

Examples: BHS Hoodie, BHS ¼ zip jacket, BHS track suit, BHS long-sleeved top, BHS active leggings, BHS gym shorts.

A combination of BHS uniform and branded apparel is a likely outfit for most students on these days
