NCSd is advocating for 9.6 billion. Questions were raised about the allocation of the CAT that was to go to schools. The Legislative Committee will work on education and advocacy. <p>Topic: Student Care Committee Time: 15 minutes Jena</p>	<p>Update, possible questions for superintendent.</p>	<p>We discussed transparency with our community.</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> - The return to in-person in the fall has raised a few questions; what has changed, why not CDL? - Plans for return to school, how are the needs of social/emotional, academic, and grade level transitions being addressed? What does reintegration look like? <p>Concerns about access to fresh food was shared at our last committee meeting, Jena was able to have a list created by Harry at Rowe. That has been shared to our Community Liaison. There are several churches in the area that are doing fresh food boxes weekly. School Yard Farms may be a program that could be integrated into schools. This will be explored and updated at our next meeting. Mental Health concerns and students well-being continue to be a theme in our discussions. We will continue to share resources on our FB page. More information regarding resources in our community are needed.</p>
