WAIVER OF THE PROCEDURAL AGREEMENT
between the
EDMONDS SCHOOL DISTRICT NO. 15
and the
EDMONDS EDUCATION ASSOCIATION
2022-23

THIS WAIVER OF THE PROCEDURAL AGREEMENT regarding **GRADING PERIODS AT SCRIBER LAKE HIGH SCHOOL** (Section 6.7 C) is effective September 1, 2022 through June 30, 2023, and is supplemental to the Procedural Agreement between the Edmonds Education Association and the Edmonds School District No. 15.

WHEREAS 13 years ago, Scriber Lake High School shifted to the year-in-a-semester/semester-in-a-quarter/quarter-in-a-session structure; and

WHEREAS this structure allows students to concentrate on 3 block classes at a time instead of 6; and

WHEREAS students fare better with only 3 classes to keep track of., have a chance to have a fresh start every 4.5 weeks and students who arrive with credit deficiencies have a chance to accelerate through challenging subjects; and

WHEREAS, during the 2020-21 school year, Scriber Lake aligned with the District grading calendar; and

WHEREAS, on May 11, 2022, 100% of the Scriber Lake Staff EEA members voted to request a waiver to continue posting grades every session for the 2022-23 school year;

THEREFORE, the parties agree as follows:

- Traditional Scriber Lake Grading
- Grades will be posted every session (middle of each quarter)
- Session Grades: will be posted 4 times per academic year
 - Teachers have 4 days to post grades
 - 2 green days at the end of those 4 days,(dates unknown at this time)
- Quarter Grades: will be posted 4 times per academic year
 - Teachers have 4 days to post grades
 - 2 green days at the end of those 4 days (dates unknown this time)
- Mini-Course grades will be due at the next session grades.
 - Mini-Course exception: Due the Friday after mini-course ends for graduation seniors.
- Total number of green days for grading annually: 14 days
