Wake Forest University is a private institution that was founded in 1834. It has a total undergraduate enrollment of 5,472 (fall 2021), its setting is suburban, and the campus size is 340 acres. It utilizes a semester-based academic calendar. Wake Forest University's ranking in the 2022-2023 edition of Best Colleges is National Universities, Number 29th. Its tuition and fees are \$62,128.

General Entry Requirement

Wake Forest University admissions is most selective with an acceptance rate of 25%. Half the applicants admitted to Wake Forest have an SAT score between 1350 and 1500 (Not required). The application deadline is Jan 1st and the application fee at Wake Forest University is \$85.

Wake Forest's business program maintains a reputation for being one of the best in the country. The School of Business's part-time MBA program has ranked #1 in North Carolina for the last twelve years, according to U.S. News & World Report. The school itself is ranked #13 of the nation's best business programs.
