Participation and Proficiency

All schools are required to test at least 95% of students to meet participation requirements.

The proficiency rate of schools that do not meet 95% participation will be impacted as follows:

Say a school has 300 students, 95% of 300 is 285. They are accountable for testing at least 285 of 300 students.

The school only tests 200 students and 100 of the 200 students are proficient resulting in a proficiency rate of 50% (100 divided by 200 = 50%)

HOWEVER!


The school did not meet the 95% accountability rate of testing at least 285 students. Any students within the 95% not tested will automatically be considered "not proficient" for calculation purposes. When the proficiency rate is calculated the 100 proficient students will be divided by the 285 students that the school was accountable for testing (100 divided by 285 = 35%). So the school's proficiency rate is now 35%










PSAT/SAT Math by School & Grade






PSAT Math Demographic Groups






SAT Math Demographic Groups








M-STEP ELA by School

M-STEP ELA by Grade








PSAT EBRW 8th Grade
