GUIDELINES AND RECOMMENDATIONS FOR CODES OF BEHAVIOR FOR COACHES, PARTICIPANTS, SPECTATORS, AND ADMINISTRATORS IN INTERSCHOLASTIC COMPETITION

THE SPECTATORS are expected to:

- 1. Conform to accepted standards of good sportsmanship and behaviors.
- 2. Respect officials, coaches, and players and extend all courtesies to them.
- 3. Refrain from feet stomping, disrespectful remarks, and the use of noisemakers.
- 4. Be quiet when players need total concentration (For example a serve in volleyball).
- 5. Obey the regulations of the building and grounds and those who do not conform should be brought to the attention of the building authorities.
- 6. Understand that schools are responsible for the conduct of their respective spectators, whether at home or away.
- 7. Refrain from shouting disapproval of calls made by officials.
