CURRICULUM COVERAGE

English and Destination Reader

In English and DR This term we will be reading the heart-warming story, 'A Boy Called Christmas'.by Matt Haig. *Where an impossibility is just a possibility you don't understand*.

Some of the genres we will be covering through this text will be diary writing, news reports and poetry.

In our Destination Reader sessions, the children will continue to develop their skills of predicting, questioning, inferring, making connections, clarifying and summarising.



Phonics and spelling

This term we will continue to work through spelling rules and applying all the phonic knowledge we have learnt previously. For the first week the spelling rule will be words ending in 'tion' as used in 'station, location, nation.'

Maths

Over the coming term, the main focus will be on addition and subtraction. This will include mental strategies for both operations, estimating and formal calculations. Throughout the term, children will continue to develop their skills of reasoning and problem solving.

Science

In science this term we will be learning about animals including humans. The children will learn about nutrition and diet. They will also learn about the skeleton, muscles, tendons and ligaments.

History

In history this term we are moving forward in time to the Bronze Age and Iron Age. The children will learn that the Bronze Age and Iron Age represented a significant change. They will learn how metals were used for tools and weapons and how this impacted on daily lives. We will learn about everyday life during these periods in history and also how people would have protected themselves.

PSHE

Our focus for PSHE this term is celebrating difference. We will also be covering bullying which will link with Anti- Bullying week taking place from 14th to 18th of November 2022. The theme of this is 'Reach Out'.
