SCHOOL POLICY REGARDING GRADUATION PROGRESS

East High School is committed to assisting all students in meeting graduation requirements. A student is not considered to be “on track” to graduate if he/she needs more credits than what his/her senior East High schedule will accommodate. If a student is not on track for graduation the student is not eligible for a reduced schedule, will be placed on academic probation, and a contract will be drawn up with specifics of how and when the student will get on track. If at any time a student exceeds more than 3.0 credits of recovery or doesn't meet the following benchmarks during their senior year, a Student Services Committee meeting may be scheduled with the student, parent, counselor, and administrator to determine the best next step or program for the student.

1. First day of 1st Quarter: Needs no more than 3.0 credits of recovery.
2. First day of 2nd Quarter: Needs no more than 2.0 credits of recovery.
3. First day of 3rd Quarter: Needs no more than 1.0 credits of recovery.
4. First day of 4th Quarter: Needs no more than .50 credits of recovery.
