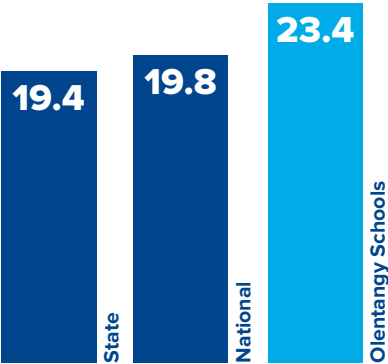

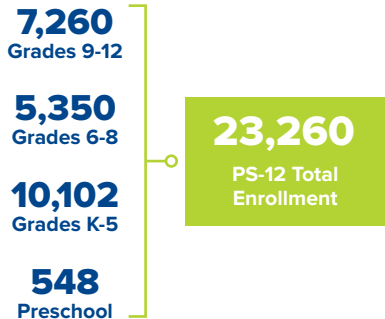

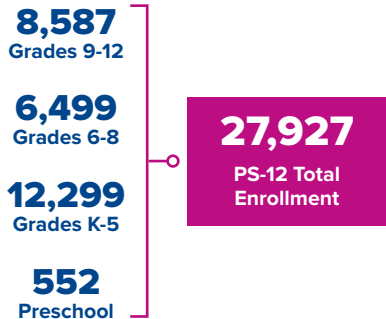

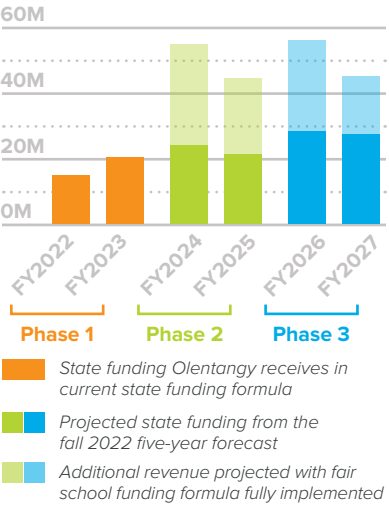

OHIO FAIR SCHOOL FUNDING PLAN

The Fair School Funding Plan’s 6-year phase-in model spans FY2022 through FY2027. The first two years, FY2022 and FY2023, were passed into the budget and increased Olentangy’s state formula funding. **However, the Olentangy community must continue to advocate for the state to fully implement the fair school funding plan.** The chart represents Olentangy’s projected state funding for FY2024-FY2027, and the increase in state revenue the District could receive with a school funding formula.
