Mr. Richards also mentioned the district will need to consider hiring a literacy coach to meet the needs of students. This position would be funded through the ARP ESSER funds.

In the future, the district may need to look at addressing a change to the future preschool fees.

Mr. Richards attended the MVCTC National Technical Honor Society presentation ceremony where multiple Valley View students participated and were inducted.

2022-060: EXECUTIVE SESSION



PRESENTATION AND DISCUSSION OF THE BUILDING PROJECT


Vonda Alberson and Steve Wilczynski from Fanning Howey Associates presented a video fly around illustrating the site layout and proposed building exterior.
