Project: Renovations Due to Grade Group Change

- **Scope:** Remodel TCES and CFES to accommodate increased student enrollment.
- **Why:** It is the recommendation of the New Facility Study group to build a 6th - 8th grade JH in the Woodlands. Based on this recommendation, the New Facility Study Group has requested the Additions and Renovations Study group consider the remodel of the TCES and CFES into K-5 campuses. Without the need for 6th Grade programs such as Band and Orchestra, these spaces could be remodeled and used to increase student capacity. This increase in student capacity at the two campuses would allow for future growth without the need to add a 4th K-5 building in The Woodlands area.
- **Schedule:** The design and remodel of these buildings would begin 2015 and would be completed at the beginning of the 2016/2017 school year to correspond with the opening of the new Junior High.
- **Potential Cost:** \$1,819,473
