- Ensure that curriculum meets the four areas of teaching ELL (reading, writing, speaking and listening).
- Develop daily lesson plans based on the needs of students.
- Maintain a volunteer network to assist students with specific skillsets.
- Assist volunteers with developing specific materials to meet individual student needs.
- Test students for placement after 40 hours in the program.
- Promote program services to potential students within the local community.
- Complete documents related to compliance training, forms that document student hours, and other paperwork.
- Must be trained in CASAS & TABE CLAS-E administration.
- Other assigned duties.
