IMPORTANT REGISTRATION AND TRANSFER INFORMATION:

Registration:

- ✓ (Tracy Unified School District) First step is to complete the Tracy Charter School Enrollment Application. Once your enrollment application is received and we have space, you will be notified, and your child will be transferred to the Tracy Charter School. You will then need to complete Data Confirmation through the Aeries Online Parent Portal.
- (Non-Tracy Unified School District) First step is to complete the Tracy Charter School Enrollment Application. Once your enrollment application is received and we have space, you will be notified. If your child is coming from another district, you must complete the Aeries Online Registration as well. This will add him to the Tracy Unified School District and assign him a Student ID that will be a requirement to complete Data Confirmation through the Aeries Online Parent Portal.



IMPORTANT REGISTRATION AND TRANSFER INFORMATION:

- ✓ Transfer: If you decide to have your student return to in person learning this year, they will return to their home school if there is space.
 - Transfers for Middle & High School Students will be at the end or beginning of each semester.
 - If there is no longer any space in your student's home school, they will be transferred to another school in the district where there is space.
 - Intra-District Transfers must be approved by Student Services. The time window is 10/15 – 1/15 (the year prior).

Independent Study (CDE): is available to pupils from kindergarten through high school and is designed to respond to the pupil's unique educational needs, interests, aptitudes, and abilities within the confines of legal authority and school board policy. Pupils who participate in independent study have the same course requirements as pupils in a regular course of study at site-based schools.

Independent Study is not Distance Learning!





STEPS TO STARTING SCHOOL

- Families must complete Orientation
- Master Agreement: Students and families will sign their Master Agreement during Orientation.
- Complete Data Confirmation for Tracy Charter
- Work Packet (for Attendance)
- Pick Courses (for 6th-12th only)





WHAT DO STUDENTS NEED TO START SCHOOL?

Students need the following materials to start their school year:

- <u>Technology</u>: TUSD computer and hotspot by the Friday after Orientation.
- <u>Grade Level Workbooks</u>: Elementary (K-5) Only by Friday as well.






ATTENDANCE AT THE CHARTER

Independent Study Attendance Procedures are used for Tracy Charter. There are 3 ways to receive credit for a day of attendance:

- 1. Attend the weekly 1 on 1 meeting with the assigned teacher.
- 2. Attend a group meeting with the assigned teacher/counselor.
- 3. Log on to Edgenuity platform for a minimum of 30 minutes per day during school hours and complete one assignment during that time.

No Sick Days or Family Days





<u>Weekly Meetings</u>: The assigned teacher will reach out to the student and family to schedule their weekly meeting time (on Friday). This is a **MANDATORY** requirement to participate in the Tracy Charter School program.

- Missed Weekly Meetings due to emergencies must be rescheduled and completed.
- After missing 3 Weekly Meetings the Administration will follow up with parent.
- If missed meetings continue to be an issue, the student will be required to attend meetings on campus.



STARTING SCHOOL

- Start Times for Students:
 - 8:00 AM for Elementary
 - 8:30 AM for Middle & High School
- The assigned teacher will send a Welcome Email on **Friday** following the Orientation. Students will need to check their TUSD student email account for this information.
- All school communications will be sent to the TUSD student email account.
- Complete Work Packet for Attendance Credit (Wednesday, Thursday & Friday).

 TECH: School device (computer-required) and school provided hot-spot with internet access with School Email Address) and Password (8-digit Date of Birth)



 - Do not use Google Products!




ACCESS THE CLEVER PAGE USING A STUDENT LAPTOP


- Click the Chrome Icon Clever is the homepage

Time on Task:

Students are expected to work on the Genius K-5 platform for 4 to 5 hours daily between the hours of 8:00am - 3:00pm, Monday -Friday. If there is a situation that a student is unable to work the necessary hours during a normal school day, then at a minimum the student should be completing at least 30 minutes and finishing one assignment during the normal school day.


