PROJECT UPDATES

The High School Project: Minnie Howard Redevelopment

- Underground utility work is continuing onsite and on West Braddock Road. Work is expected to continue through the end of the year, including Virginia American Water.
- The first concrete slab on grade was poured at the end of October, and more pours will follow in the upcoming months.
 - The contractor has been approved for extended work hours as required for concrete work and will request extensions as needed for the large concrete slab pours.
- Site excavation is ongoing and will continue in the south area of the building.
- The crane and steel arrived at the end of October, and steel erection began in multiple areas of the north side of the building.
 - The second crane will arrive in mid-November.
- Footings and foundation walls will start on the south side of the building, along with underslab utilities in this area.
- Submittals and fabrications are continuing for all upcoming work

Douglas MacArthur Modernization Project

- The following work is ongoing:
 - Interior framing
 - Duct work, Plumbing Fitout, and Conduit installation
 - Fireproofing
 - Retaining Walls, Sidewalk, and Curb installation
 - Flushing and testing of the Geothermal system
 - Bioretention Basins installation
 - Mechanical Equipment installation
 - Exterior Sheathing
 - Waterline installation
 - Site Walls 1 and 2 Installation
- Decking for the roof and Roof parapet are being installed.

- Parking garage repairs ongoing; Concrete pour scheduled for November 15; substantial completion expected by the end of month
- Additional fencing work complete
- Perimeter fence bids reviewed and evaluated by staff and consultants; contract being finalized
