District Advisory Council (DAC) Meeting Notes

Wednesday, October 26, 2022

9:30 a.m. – 11:00 a.m.

Cathleen Corella welcomed everyone to the District Advisory Council meeting and stated how great it was to finally meet in person. She reminded participants that agenda, minute notes, and other documents shared in the meeting would be sent via email. In addition, they would also be posted on the DAC website. Site Representatives can always refer to the website and share information with parent groups.

TOPICS DISCUSSED:

- **Human Trafficking Awareness- Stacey Fitzgerald/Prevention Advocate for Everfree**
 - Stacey clarified that human trafficking is not smuggling. She further dispelled myths, revealed alarming statistics on this multi-billion-dollar industry and she discussed risk factors and warning signs.
 - Stacey presented videos demonstrating how social media can provide easy access to victims and how sextortion complaints have tripled in the last year.
 - She further discussed that Foster Youth are high risk targets and parents can use resources to monitor their children's devices. For example, Canopy, KidsGuard Pro, PhoneSheriff, Bark, Net Nanny, Qustodio, and Ogyomgy are a few applications that some DAC representatives have personally used.
- **ELOP- Adolfo Herrera/ Administrator, TK-12 Innovative & Expanded Learning Opportunities Jaime Beidler/Child Development Services/CARES Expanded Learning Supervisor**
 - Adolfo explained in great details what is ELOP, the requirements and what a nine-hour day would look like during the school year.
 - Jaime talked how ELOP brings to campuses academic activities for example, Lego robotics, language support, drone academy, as well as enrichment activities that are being planned to support our students, for example, cooking, pep squad, photography to name a few.
 - Jaime and Adolfo discussed the timeline and what to expect for the next few months, including summer programming. They expect these funds will continue, be ongoing and appropriated annually with anticipation of increases to Orange Unified School District.
- **District Safety Task Force- Heriberto Angel/Executive Director, Student Community Services**
 - Heriberto described how this is part of OUSD Strategic Initiative 3.0 and how local enforcement, school sites, community stakeholders, and Orange Unified School District will work together to update current safety and security measures.
 - He further explained three areas of focus that were of most importance to the task force, which included safety & security measures, professional development, and mental health.
- **Educational Services Team & Parent Resources/Workshops**
 - Cathleen presented Educational Services Executive Directors as the backbone to OUSD. If anyone needs to reach out to them with questions, DAC representatives can contact Educational Services.
 - Cathleen reminded DAC representatives to share the information learned in our meeting with their school sites.
